# Let's look at definite articles

- Definite articles translate to “THE” in English.

Think of it this way → whenever you would tell someone that you want THE apple on the table, not just any apple, that's when you would use the definite article.


- Definite articles in Spanish are either masculine or feminine; and they can be singular or plural.

Think → THE apple or THE APPLES on the counter.


	Singular	Plural
Masculine	el	los
Feminine	la	las



# Adding colors as adjectives


 In English, we would add the color of an object before the name.

Example: The white house.

 In Spanish, we add the color of an object **AFTER** the name.


Example: La casa blanca. (The house white).





Like other adjectives, names of the common colors when used in Spanish must agree with the nouns they describe in both gender and number.

Note that the form changes depending on the number and gender of what's being described:.)

- **El coche amarillo.** (*The **yellow** car.*)
  - **Los coches amarillos.** (*The **yellow** cars.*)
  - **La flor amarilla.** (*The **yellow** flower.*)
  - **Las flores amarillas.** (*The **yellow** flowers.*)

# Try it!
