

## LOS PODEROSOS PRONOMBRES

Pronouns replace nouns.

They can (1) the subject, (2) the object, or (3) both!

### SUBJECT PRONOUNS

yo, tú, él, ella, usted, nosotros, ellos, ellas, ustedes

### REFLEXIVE PRONOUNS

Indicate that the subject & the object are the SAME.


The person receiving the action is the same as the person doing the action!

me	nos
te	os
se	se

### DIRECT OBJECT PRONOUNS

Indicate WHO or WHAT the subject is talking about.

Answer the questions: WHAT? Or WHO?




me	nos
te	os
lo	los
la	las

### INDIRECT OBJECT PRONOUNS

Indicate the direction of the action.

Answers the questions: FOR WHOM? TO WHOM?



me	nos
te	os
le*	les*

(\*Change to "se" when followed by lo, la, los, or las.)

### INDIRECT OBJECT PRONOUNS

Indicate the direction of the action.

Answers the questions: FOR WHOM? TO WHOM?



me	nos
te	os
le*	les*

(\*Change to "se" when followed by lo, la, los, or las.)

## RULES of PRONOUN PLACEMENT

WHERE do I put them?

1. Before a conjugated verb
2. Attached to the end of an infinitive
3. Attached to the end of a POSITIVE command.
4. Before a NEGATIVE command.

WHAT order do I write them in?

1. Subject, IO, DO, conjugated verb
2. Infinitive+IO+DO
3. Positive Command + IO + DO
4. No, IO, DO, Negative Command

+ = attached!

## RULES of PRONOUN PLACEMENT

WHERE do I put them?

5. Before a conjugated verb
6. Attached to the end of an infinitive
7. Attached to the end of a POSITIVE command.
8. Before a NEGATIVE command.

WHAT order do I write them in?

5. Subject, IO, DO, conjugated verb
6. Infinitive+IO+DO
7. Positive Command + IO + DO
8. No, IO, DO, Negative Command

+ = attached!
